**A Note About Our Native Plants:** All species provided through this sale are native to the Delaware-Otsego Audubon region and exhibit moderate to high deer resistance. Plants will be in 3.5" to 4.25" pots (unless indicated otherwise) and each will be labeled. Information sheets on each plant species will be available with your plants at pickup as well as on the DOAS Website.

## INDIVIDUAL PLANTS

**Aquilegia canadensis (wild columbine) \$9 each** # \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
Prefers partial shade, but is adaptable. It will grow to approximately 1-3 feet in height; red and yellow flowers that bloom in May/June. Best soil is moist and well-drained with a neutral pH; Grows in zones 3-8; moderate deer resistance. This is a great plant to provide nectar for hummingbirds and hawk moths as well as seeds for finches.

**Asclepias incarnata (swamp milkweed) \$9.00 each** # \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
Prefers sun to partial shade; Grows to approximately 2-5 feet; Pink to purple flowers that bloom in July-September. Best soil is moist with neutral to slightly acidic pH. It grows in zones 3-8 and has a high deer resistance. This is an important plant for monarch caterpillars. It also attracts other butterflies, hummingbirds and songbirds.

**Asclepias tuberosa (butterfly milkweed) \$9.00 each** # \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
This plant prefers sun to partial sun and will grow to approximately 1-2.5 feet in height. It has orange flowers that bloom in June-August. Best soil for this plant is dry to average with neutral pH. It grows in zones 3-9 and has a high deer resistance. This is a good plant for monarch caterpillars and a variety of other butterflies.

**Eragrostis spectabilis (purple lovegrass) \$9.00 each** # \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
This plant prefers sunshine and will grow to approximately 1-2 feet in height. It has reddish-purple flowers that bloom in July-August. It does well in soils that are dry to average with a wide range of pH.

**Eurybia divaricata (white wood aster) \$9.00 each** # \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
This plant prefers partial to full shade and will grow to approximately 2-3 feet in height. It has white flowers with yellow to red disks that bloom from around September-November. It does well in soils that are medium to dry with a slightly acidic to neutral pH.

**Eutrochium purpureum (purple Joe pyeweed) \$9.00 each** # \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
This plant prefers sun to partial shade and will grow to approximately 4-7 feet in height. It has pale pink to purple flowers that bloom July-September. Best soil for this plant is moist to medium and it can tolerate a wide range of pH. It grows in zones 4-8 and has a high deer resistance. This is a good plant for attracting butterflies, songbirds and other pollinators.

**Helenium autumnale (sneezeweed) \$9.00 each** # \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
This plant prefers sunny locations and will grow to approximately 3-5 feet in height. It has yellow flowers that bloom August-October. Best soil for this plant is medium to wet, with a pH in the range of about 6.0-7.0.

**Iris versicolor (blue flag) \$9.00 each** # \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
This plant prefers sun to partial shade and will grow to approximately 2-3 feet in height. It has violet blue flowers that bloom May-June. Best soil for this plant is moist to wet.

**Lobelia cardinalis (cardinal flower) \$9.00 each** # \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
This plant prefers sun to partial shade and will grow to approximately 1-6 feet in height. It has vibrant red flowers that bloom June-September. Best soil for this plant is moist with a neutral to mildly acidic pH. It grows in zones 2-9 and has a moderate deer resistance. The nectar of the flowers attracts the Ruby-Throated Hummingbird and various Swallowtail butterflies.

**Lobelia siphilitica (great blue lobelia) \$9.00 each** # \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
This plant prefers sun to shade and will grow to approximately 2-3 feet in height. It has blue flowers that bloom June-September. Best soil for this plant is moist with a neutral to mildly acidic pH. It grows in zones 4-9 and has a moderate deer resistance. The nectar of the flowers is attractive to hummingbirds.

**Monarda didyma (bee balm) \$9.00 each** # \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
This plant prefers sun to partial shade and will grow to approximately 2-4 feet in height. It has red flowers that bloom July-September. Best soil for this plant is moist with a slightly acidic pH. It grows in zones 3-9 and has a moderate deer resistance. It is attractive to bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds.

**Monarda fistulosa (Oswego tea) \$9.00 each** # \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
This plant prefers sun to partial shade and will grow to approximately 2-4 feet in height. It has pink/purple shades of flowers that bloom July-September. Best soil for this plant is average with a neutral range pH. It grows in zones 3-9 and has a moderate deer resistance. It is attractive for birds, butterflies, and hummingbirds.

**Panicum virgatum (switchgrass) \$9.00 each** # \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
This plant prefers sun to partial shade and will grow to approximately 3-6 feet in height. It has pink-tinged flowers that bloom July-February. Best soil for this plant is average. It does well with a wide range pH.

**Penstemon hirsutus (hairy beardtongue) \$9.00 each** # \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_  
This plant prefers sun to partial shade and will grow to approximately 1-2 feet in height. It has pink and purple shade flowers that bloom June-July. Best soil for this plant is average to dry with a slightly acidic pH. It grows in zones 3-9 and has a high deer resistance. It attracts native bees and is the larval host for the Baltimore Checkerspot butterfly.

**Pycnanthemum tenuifolium (narrow-leaved mountain mint) \$9.00 each**

# \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_

This plant prefers sun to partial shade and will grow to approximately 1-2 feet in height. It has pink and purple shade flowers that bloom June-July. Best soil for this plant is average to dry with a slightly acidic pH. It grows in zones 3-9 and has a high deer resistance. It attracts native bees and is the larval host for the Baltimore Checkerspot butterfly.

**Symphotrichum laeve (smooth aster) \$9.00 each**

# \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_

This plant prefers sun to partial sun and will grow to approximately 2-4 feet in height. It has violet flowers that bloom September-October. Best soil for this plant is average to dry. It does well with a flexible pH. It grows in zones 4-8 and has a moderate deer resistance. This plant attracts numerous bees and butterflies. It is a larval host for the Pearl Crescent (Phyciodes tharos) butterfly. Songbirds and small mammals eat the seeds.

**Symphotrichum novae-angliae (New England aster) \$9.00 each**

# \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_

This plant prefers sun to partial shade and will grow to approximately 3-6 feet in height. It has purple flowers that bloom August-October. Best soil for this plant is acidic with pH of less than 6.8.

**Tiarella cordifolia (foamflower) \$9.00 each**

# \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_

This plant prefers partial shade and will grow to approximately .75-1 foot in height. It has white flowers that bloom in May. Best soil for this plant is average to moist with a neutral range pH.

**Viola striata (striped violet) \$9.00 each**

# \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_

This plant prefers partial shade and will grow to approximately 8-12 inches in height. It has cream colored flowers with purple striations that bloom in May and June. Best soil for this plant is average to moist and well-drained, with a neutral range pH.

**Veronicastrum virginicum (Culver's root) \$9.00 each**

# \_\_\_\_\_ x \$ 9.00 ea = \$ \_\_\_\_\_

This plant prefers partial shade and will grow to approximately 3-6 feet in height. It has white spikes for flowers that bloom August-September. Best soil for this plant is average moisture and neutral range pH.
